• Folio | Lighting and Studio Photography

Your advanced skills in studio lighting and post-production are integrated into your image making and enhance your ability to express yourself through the process of concept development and using photography as an expressive medium.

What You Will Learn:

In this unit you will work with a wide range of subject matter as you explore Still Life and Portraiture in our professional studio environment. You will hone your skills in a range of lighting systems, lighting styles and studio photography applications, employ a range of studio lighting techniques and create mood and aesthetic outcomes.

Explore and Apply Photo Lighting Techniques

- Produce highly creative photo images
- Work with a range of professional photo lighting techniques
- Learn to select and control lighting for creative effect
- Understand light quality in a studio environment
- Produce dynamic images in a professional studio

Explore Creativity through Photographic Practice

- Produce a professional folio of creative images
- Develop ideas and design photographs with technical skill
- Use visual communication tools
- Apply conceptual image construction techniques



Post-Production | Compositing & Retouching

Expand on your creative opportunities and develop a broader range of skills through your postproduction practices to realize dynamic photographic imagery that plays with illusions of reality.

What You Will Learn:

Learn new post-production techniques and begin to develop a visual style for your photographs. Gain confidence in editing and retouching using Adobe Creative Cloud software and manage your files and workflow to produce your own digital prints.

Develop Realistic Compositing

- Learn to use Photoshop in a professional way
- Produce realistic composite images
- Use professional digital processing and manipulation techniques
- Edit images for creative effect

Design and Perform Fashion and Editorial Retouching

- · Learn to design and implement creative retouching
- Develop retouching skills using professional techniques and styles
- Develop people-based fashion and editorial retouching abilities



Workshop | Fine Printing

The fine print continues to be held in high regard in photography. This unit provides you with the skills needed to produce high quality digital prints. Using Adobe Photoshop, you will develop a clear understanding of how to prepare your images for printing to a professional level. You will also experiment with different types of papers and surfaces - and the processes that can be used to achieve a variety of outcomes

Produce Fine Prints

- Learn about trends in printing techniques
- Produce high quality photographic prints
- Create professional prints for customers, clients or exhibition

Equipment & Materials

You need your DSLR or mirrorless camera with interchangeable lenses, two external hard drives (one for day-to-day usage and one for backup) and a tripod. You will also need your own subscription to the Adobe Creative Cloud Photography Plan. There will also be the cost of printing materials for the workshop | fine printing and folio.

Lighting & Studio

You need a portable flash unit capable of TTL output for your camera, and the PSC Studio Kit available from the PSC Shop.

Folio

You need to allow for material costs, including printing and mounting of your photographs to a professional standard. Details of these costs are available from PSC's Print Shop.


Post-Production
